## **Call for Presentation Proposals**

Deadline: Friday, August 15, 2014, 4:00 p.m.

The LSUHSC-New Orleans Academy for the Advancement of Educational Scholarship is sponsoring its annual Fall Symposium and Educational Scholarship Day on Thursday, October 9, 2014. Presentation proposals are solicited for poster and oral abstract presentations and interactive sessions (e.g., demonstrations) to showcase teaching, learning, and educational innovations, excellence, and scholarly work.

All LSUHSC faculty members are invited to submit presentation proposals for consideration. Proposals will be peer reviewed based on the format and criteria described below. Priority will be given to accepted proposals involving Academy members, with those from non-members being accepted as space permits. Faculty members are encouraged to submit presentation proposals for work not yet published or presented, as well as work that has been previously presented at professional meetings.

Preparation of presentation materials are the responsibility of the authors/presenters. Use of existing posters or alternate ways of presenting when poster printing is cost prohibitive is encouraged. Budgetary limitations should not interfere with one's ability to submit and present scholarly work in teaching and education. Accepted presentations and demonstrations will occur the morning of October 9 and the remainder of the day will include activities comprising the Fall Symposium for which this year's theme will focus on teaching quality and quality improvement in health professions education. Plans are well underway and details of the full day program will be forthcoming soon.

Please be sure to adhere to the proposal format and address clearly the review criteria listed below. Upon completion of the peer review process, first authors will be notified of acceptance via email no later than Wednesday, September 10, 2014. - Quality (e.g., soundness) of conclusions
