

Log in to Residency Partner by going to <https://lsuhsc.residencypartner.com> and use your LSU username, password, and LSUHSC as the institution.

\*\*\* Note: The terminology “GME Competency Exams” within Residency Partner is going to be changing to “Core Curriculum Exams.” When this happens, everything will work the same, but the screen will say “Core Curriculum Exams” instead of “GME Competency Exams.” No other changes will happen, and the exams can still be taken with the instructions provided in this document.

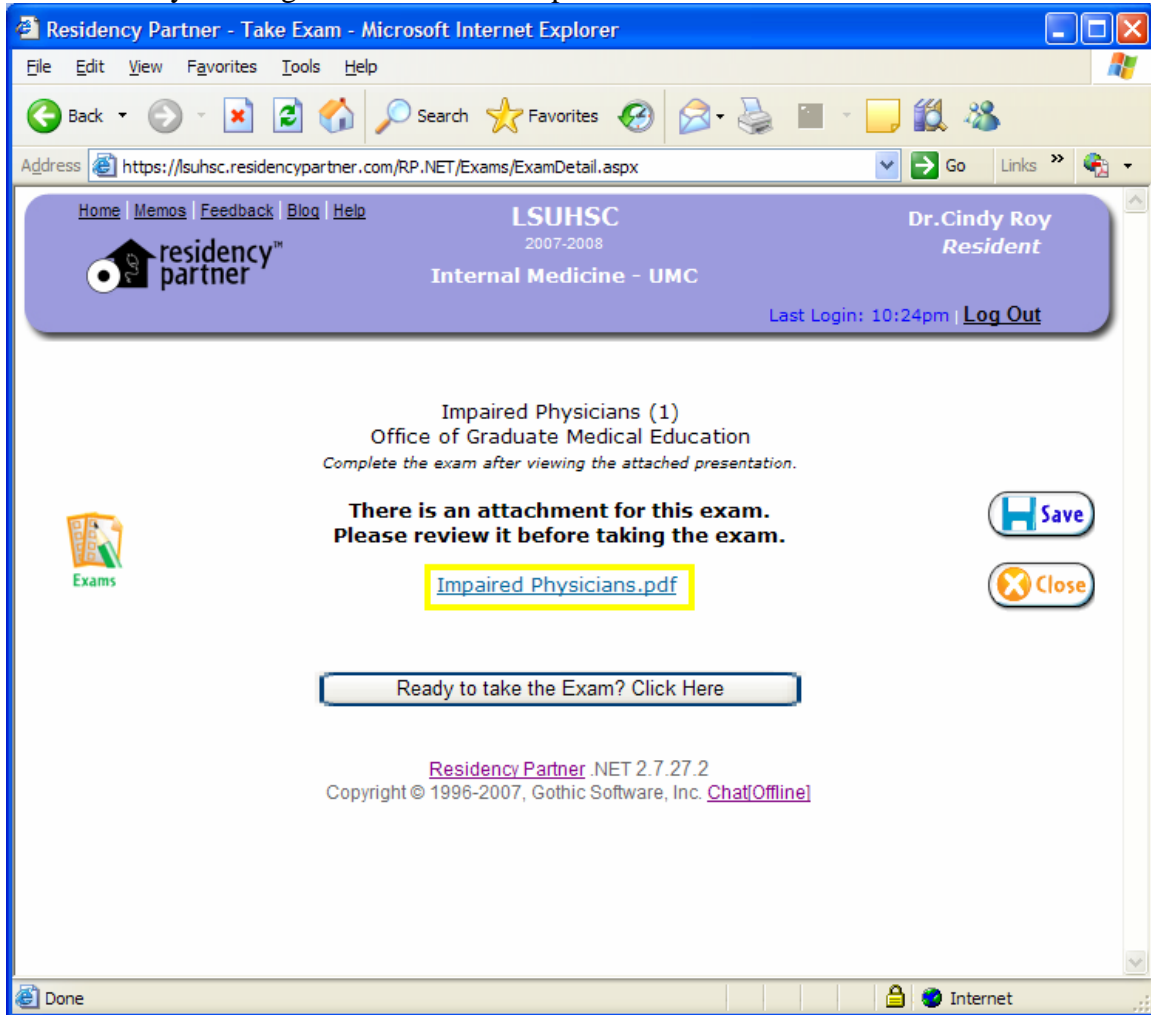

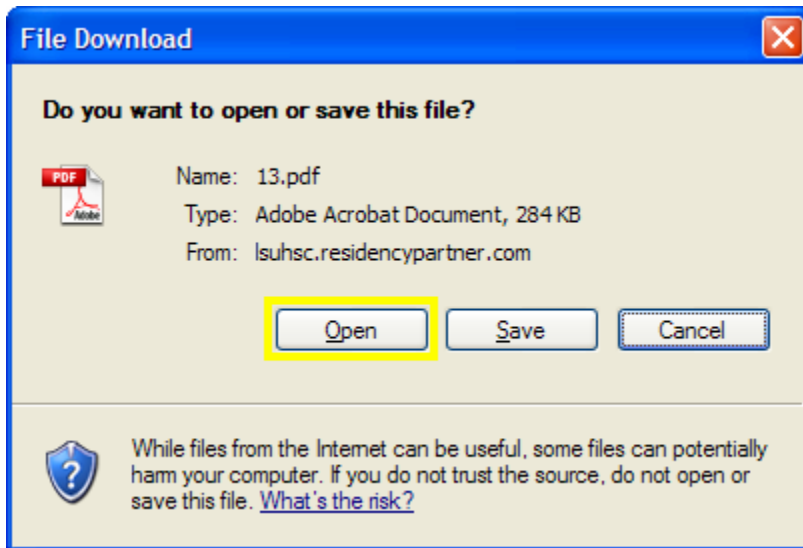
Click “Take Exam”.

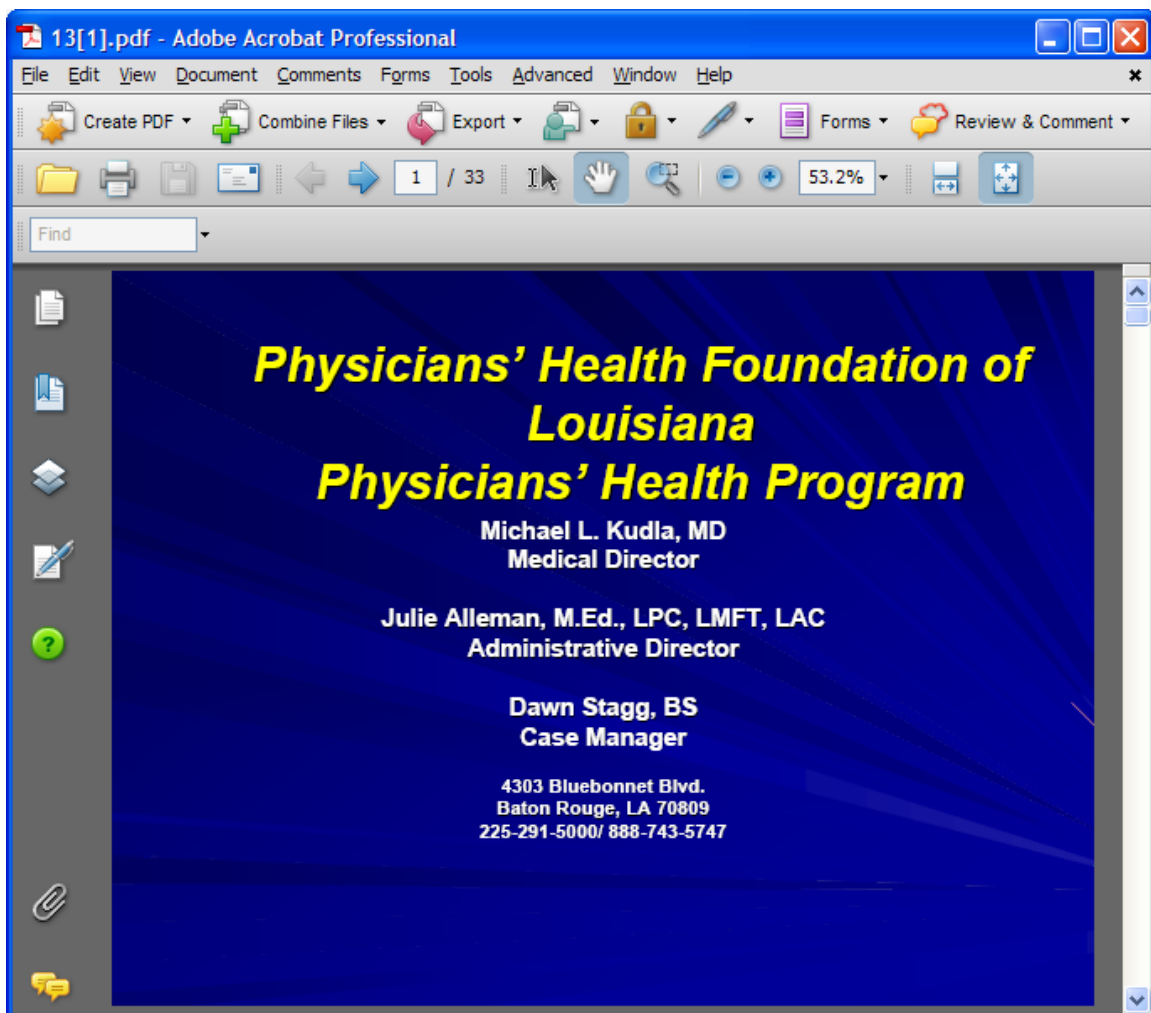


Click the “**Open**” button to view the attached presentation.

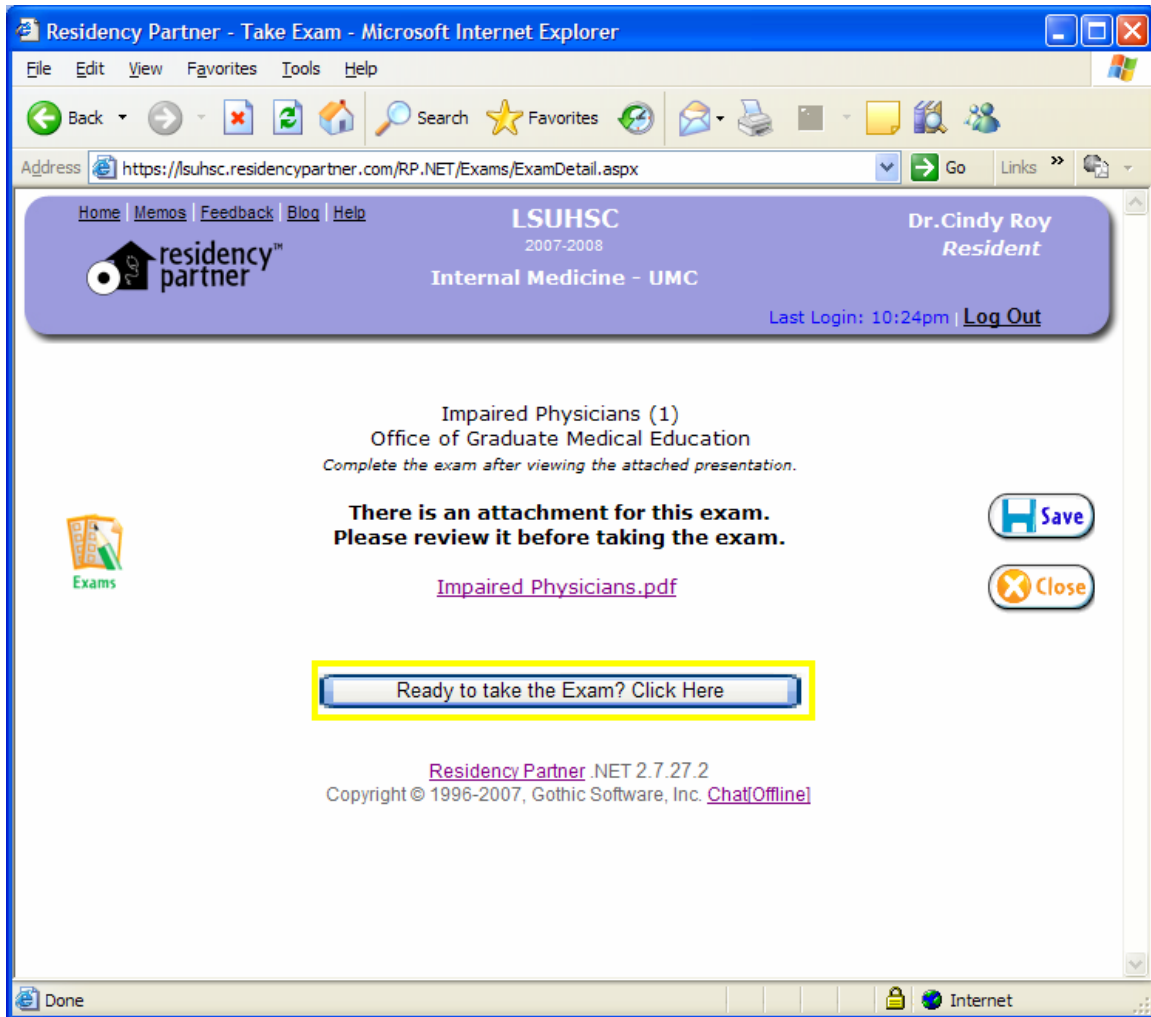

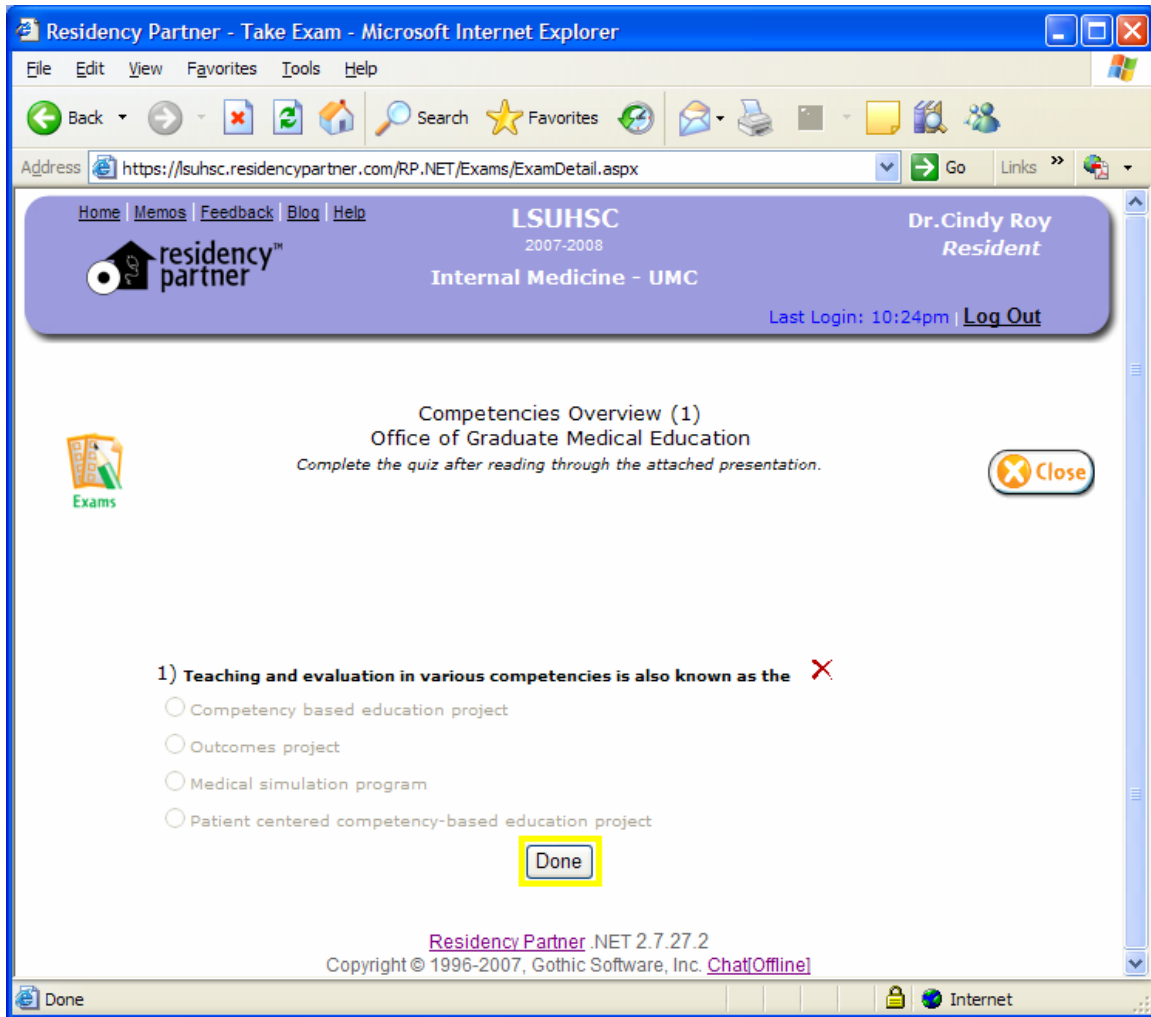
