Who can help you to accomplish your research goals?

The Faculty Interest Database (FID) is maintained by the School of Medicine, and anyone can search the database to learn who in the LSUHSC community has expertise in specific research techniques, access to specialized equipment, or specific clinical interests.

However, individual faculty members need to input their information in order to be included in the search results. The link to the webpage is below. Click on the Faculty Interest Database on the left hand side of the webpage. If you would like to be included in the database, please logon and enter your information requested. You can enter your research interests, relevant expertise, available equipment in your lab etc.
