

TRANSFER TO LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF MEDICINE IN ADVANCE STANDING

Students from medical schools accredited by the LCME in the United States and Canada will be considered for transfer as follows:

1. Louisiana Residents will be given first priority.
2. Only those students who are in good standing at their Schools of Medicine will be accepted; it is preferred to accept them at the end of the second year.
3. The number of students accepted will not exceed that number which will restore the third year class to its original size after counting all students who are repeating the year or who were readmitted.
4. The prospective student must meet the same qualifications and requirements needed for admission to the Louisiana State University School of Medicine.
5. The applicant must be able to meet all requirements for graduation with the class that the student is entering. All students must have passed Step 1 of the USMLE before they can be accepted into the third year curriculum.
6. The student must send or have sent to the Dean of Student Affairs the following documents:
 - a. From the Medical school which the student is attending
 - i. A letter from the Dean of the School of Medicine
 - ii. A transcript
 - iii. Two letters of recommendation from faculty members.
 - iv. A letter from the finance office
 - b. Additional required documents are
 - i. A completed application form.
 - ii. Scores from the medical college admission test.
 - iii. Transcripts from all pre-medical schools attended.
 - iv. An application fee of \$30.00
 - v. A personal letter describing yourself and why you wish to transfer to Louisiana State University School of Medicine in New Orleans.
7. The prospective student must present himself/herself for a series of Interviews. The time for the interviews is to be arranged with the Dean of Student Affairs.
8. The Deadline for filing a completed application (including all required material) is February 15th of the year the student wishes to enter the School of Medicine.
9. The decision by the Committee on Transfers to accept provisionally, reject or put on a waiting list will be made at the earliest possible time. The actual date of acceptance of some may be later in the year. Final acceptance will occur later in the summer pending the achievement of a passing score on Step 1 of the USMLE, taken in of the year of acceptance.
