

### **PEDI 418 – Secondary Acting Internship – HEME/ONC**

o The student functions as an intern in the evaluation and management of hospitalized pediatric patients with hematologic and oncologic conditions under the direct supervision of house officers and faculty. Particular emphasis is given to improving clinical judgment, medical decision making, and systems-based practice by giving students more responsibility for patient care than they had in the third year. During the Acting Internship, the student will complete two weeks of Heme/Onc wards, one week of Heme/Onc subspecialty clinics, and one week of Heme/Onc night float. Evaluations will be based on day-to-day observations by faculty and house officers while the student is performing assigned duties. The experience is offered at Children’s Hospital of New Orleans.
