#### Dr. Nell Pape Waring Pediatric Allergy-Immunology

- One of New Orleans' earliest female physicians.
- Graduated from Tulane University School of Medicine in **1951**
- Residency in pediatrics at **Johns Hopkins University**
- Immeasurable devotion to her family, putting her medical **career on hold for two decades to raise her five sons.**
- *Returned to medicine in 1974 and ultimately completed her pediatric residency as well as a fellowship in allergy and immunology at Tulane University.*
- Joined the allergy and immunology department at Children's Hospital
