

GETTING STARTED: CREATING AN INTERACTIVE LECTURE WORKSHEET

STEP 1. Specific Topic/Content Area: _____

Step 2. List the essential points that are vital for the residents to learn about this topic.

Step 3. Select or Create a Case or Cases. Write Out the Case Story.

Step 4. Determine how to reveal case (e.g. Will you revolve the lecture around one case or just a chief complaint? Will you present the entire history and physical exam or have the residents ask for the pertinent history and physical exam?)

- One case
- Multiple cases
- Total reveal (chief complaint, history, physical and labs)
- Partial reveal

Step 5. Create the worksheet and formulate stimulus questions. List some additional possible higher order questions related to your topic. (Think again about your essential teaching points.)

Step 6. Develop a few slides with pertinent information, images, charts, summaries.
