





CORE is a new MKSAP enhancement that provides physicians with additional multiple-choice questions that are highly relevant to their practice and by which they can demonstrate knowledge proficiency and commitment to longitudinal learning. ACP MKSAP learners can unlock the CORE quizzes for a subspecialty after answering ACP MKSAP questions and meeting progress and proficiency thresholds. If learners meet the passing threshold for a CORE quiz, they will receive a CORE badge confirming their achievement, and after earning the designated number of badges, they can earn and print a CORE certificate for inclusion in their professional portfolio.






