<u>Dr. Stephanie Taylor</u> (Infectious Diseases) and colleagues recently published this multicenter, randomized, controlled, noninferiority trial of the use of one doses or three weekly doses of Benzathine Penicillin G in early syphilis. Primary endpoints were seroreversion to nonreactive status or a serologic response. The team found one dose was non-inferior to treatment with three doses with regard to serologic response 6 months after treatment.

<u>Dr. Catherine Hudson</u> (Gastroenterology) will be presenting her data on use of point of care ultrasound (POCUS) prior to endoscopy for patients on GLP-1s to assess aspiration risk at the American Foregut Society's annual conference in Dallas.
