


# Postbaccalaureate Research Education Program in Biomedical Sciences PREP



# PROGRAM DETAILS

A dynamic mentored research experience in a supportive environment characterized by outstanding research resources, a cooperative approach to research, and an atmosphere with the highest level of mutual respect among all students and staff

- One-year research assistantships available
- Salary of \$27,200 for one year
- Three one-week laboratory rotations for careful matching between student and mentor research areas of interest
- Extensive mentoring on oral and written skills, career choices, and applying to graduate school
- GRE preparation
- Travel awards to attend scientific conferences
- Funded by the National Institute of General Medical Sciences (NIGMS)



## ELIGIBILITY

- United States citizen or a permanent resident
- Obtained baccalaureate degree from an accredited U.S. college or university less than 36 months prior to PREP application date
- Individuals from groups that have been shown to be underrepresented in biomedical research
