Dr. Kirk Thame serves as an Associate Professor and Division Chief in the Department of Pediatrics at Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center, New Orleans. In addition to his academic roles, he is the Vice Chair of Community Engagement and Health Equity for the department. His leadership extends to Manning Family Children's of New Orleans, where he holds the positions of Service Line Chief and Division Head of Pediatric Gastroenterology, Hepatology, and Nutrition. Furthermore, he serves as the Medical Director of the Colorectal Clinic.

Dr. Thame embarked on his medical career by earning his MBBS degree from the University of the West Indies in Kingston, Jamaica. He completed his Pediatric Residency at Jackson Memorial Hospital/University of Miami and specialized in Pediatric Gastroenterology through a fellowship at St. Louis Children's Hospital/Washington University. Following positions at University of Alabama-Birmingham and Vanderbilt University, Dr. Thame joined the LSUHSC faculty in 2024.

2. Understand the information provided by motility studies.
3. Review the clinical application of motility study results
4. Discuss future directions for motility testing
