A Message from the Dean



In the fall edition, I mentioned the major laboratory renovation on floors 5, 6, and 7 of the Medical Education Building. Demolition of those floors began in October and was completed in February 2023. Construction of the new lab space and office suites will begin this spring, and will be completed within two years. This will be an amazing advancement for our researchers, and it will allow us to recruit scientists for the future. I also mentioned that we hired Dr. Peter DeBlieux to develop the educational programs in the new Center for Advanced Learning and Simulation (CALS) building. He has begun hiring staff, and is working with industry partners to help outfit the simulation centers. He will speak to Committee of 100 members in June, and I think his innovative vision for the CALS building will generate excitement.

In the fall, LSU, LCMC, Tulane and the Louisiana Cancer Research Center (LCRC) all signed an agreement that LSU will lead the effort to obtain a National Cancer Institute (NCI) designated Cancer Center for Louisiana. Aligning these four institutions took a lot of effort. We are in the best position to apply for this important designation from NCI. We have strong research and clinical programs, including an excellent network of clinical trials and community outreach. Our clinical

footprint across Southern Louisiana and our relationships with other institutions statewide also makes LSU the logical choice to apply for NCI designation. Dr. Joe Ramos, CEO of the LCRC, became a full time LSU faculty member on January 1st, and he will lead this multi-year effort.

In the coming years, the school will undertake two large planning projects. First, we will undergo reaccreditation by the Liaison Committee on Medical Education (LCME) in October 2025. Our last accreditation visit in 2017 was very successful, and we received the maximum 8-year term of accreditation. Even though the LCME site visit is 18 months away, we have begun preparing. The required self-study is a huge undertaking. Numerous faculty committees and student committees will collect large amounts of data and write voluminous reports – all of which will be submitted to the LCME in the summer of 2025. Dr. Robin English will lead this effort, and we are all grateful for her willingness to take on this monumental task. Second, in March, we began developing a five-year strategic plan for the School of Medicine. We have engaged a consulting firm in Baton Rouge to guide this project. They will conduct interviews, surveys, and focus groups with large numbers of school personnel as well as external stakeholders (including alumni). They will help us define concrete, aspirational goals with specific targets for growth in our clinical operations, our research enterprise, and our educational programs for the next five years. Given that the research and clinical environments have become increasingly competitive, having clear goals and objectives is important. You will hear more about both efforts in future editions.

With the advent of spring important events close out the academic year. Match Day, held March 15th , was attended by 175 medical school students and 80% of graduates will stay in the state and enter an LSU Health residency program. The class of 2024 will graduate on May 16th and we will wish them well as they move on to the next phase of their training. In June, we will welcome a new group of interns, and senior residents will transition from residency into practice.

We could not carry out our mission to train the next generation of doctors for Louisiana without the help of the Alumni Association. Thank you for your ongoing support.

Reflections on Technology and Transformation

A Conversation with Daryl P. Lofaso, PhD, MEd, RRT, CHSE

As the LSU School of Medicine sets its sights on expansion of its facilities and learning centers, we at the alumni office invite you to take a closer look at the integral role the current facilities, with its modernized-equipment and forward-thinking approach, have made in strengthening education. These advancements have significantly enhanced the learning experience and teaching capabilities for students and faculty, profoundly impacting their clinical, academic, and professional journeys.

We asked seasoned faculty member, Daryl P. Lofaso, PhD, MEd, RRT, CHSE, Assistant Professor – Research, Director of Simulation Operations and Director of Clinical Skills Lab, about the impact of the medical school's state-of-the-art facilities on education. His dedication, expertise, and hands-on training over the past 20+ years have helped uniquely prepare the healthcare professionals of tomorrow.

Can you provide some history about the advanced learning facilities?

The LSU Health Isidore Cohn, Jr., MD, Student Learning Center and the Clinical Skills Lab (CSL) opened August 2001 and was immediately incorporated into the LSU School of Medicine curriculum. For over two decades the learning center has created space and programming for all levels of healthcare learners, facilitating training on cadavers, high-low fidelity patient simulators, or procedure task trainers. This innovative environment has contributed to the formation of outstanding physicians who have graduated and now practice throughout the United States.

How have these innovations impacted education?

The CSL format is a fast-paced structured learning environment that assures an introduction and practice of hands-on experiences for medical students. The students are introduced to patient assessments, procedures, and critical thinking skills that are commonly performed in the patient environment. This early exposure to standardized procedural tasks permits the development of competency-based training for all medical students. These skills that are introduced in the first two years of medical school function as critical building blocks for future patient care encounters. All medical students are assessed for their ability to perform patient care tasks and receive direct, real-time feedback on their performance. The CSL challenges students and exposes them to a variety of essential clinical skills that will enhance their ability to care for patients.

The CSL and simulation space also fosters faculty development in medical education, creating the next generation of medical educators who are comfortable using simulation as an ideal problem-based learning platform.



What has your experience been while in this role?

I have had the privilege of teaching all of our medical students entering the Skills Lab for the past 22 years. In this time, approximately 4,200 medical students rotated through the Center. Our students believe that the CSL is a standard platform across medical schools. When they participate in away rotations, they quickly discover their skills are more advanced compared to most medical students due to our training environment at LSU. Over the years, students have shared their experience on how our Skills Lab training has given them an opportunity to advance their procedure training. Just last month, a former student, now a practicing physician, shared that the skills learned in the lab are used daily. These types of experiences have been shared numerous times by graduates over the past two decades. They are grateful for the opportunity to have trained in our Skills Lab.

Have the innovations benefited the school in other ways?

The Cohn Student Learning Center and the Clinical Skills Lab have also allowed us to partner with our faculty and industry to remain on the forefront of surgical and procedural

interventions by training local, regional, and national physicians in the latest surgical techniques. It also has opened the door for recruiting future medical students. In any given year, the LSU School of Medicine admits between three to five prospective students that have previously participated in the Area Health Education Center (AHEC) Day with the Doctor (DWTD) program, a community outreach initiative that offers high school students the opportunity to spend the day with second-year medical school students. Currently, we have four medical students in the second-year class that participated in the DWTD program. These medical students have shared how special it is to see their experience come full circle.

A Special Thanks and New Call to Action

The LSU School of Medicine and Dr. Lafaso are grateful for the generous support of the school's alumni and friends in helping to make this facility available over two decades ago. The Office of Alumni Affairs, then under the direction of Associate Dean **Russell Klein ('59)**, played an integral role in the fundraising, design, and construction of the Cohn Learning Center and Skills Lab with the support of the LSU Medical Alumni Association's Board of Directors.

At the request of leadership, a collaborative effort will soon be underway to assist in fundraising for additional state-of-the art advanced

technology expansion projects like the newly built LSU Health Center for Advanced Learning and Simulation (CALS). The lab will allow students the opportunity to gain experience and train in a virtual hospital setting. **Peter DeBlieux ('88)**, Assistant Dean for Advance Learning and Simulation, will lead the effort to plan, develop and implement clinical training and assessment programs in the CALS training center. Dr. DeBlieux has been recognized by students and residents as an outstanding educator and has won numerous teaching awards. "It is an exciting time, and we look forward to partnering with others to make these initiatives a reality for the future of medical education at LSU," said Dr. DeBlieux.



"I am more than happy to support my alma mater in any way possible. It is my desire that LSU succeeds in its pursuit of training many generations of exceptional physicians for many years to come. LSU Announces Dr. Steve Nelson as Chancellor of LSU Health New Orleans

Dr. Steve Nelson will serve as Chancellor of LSU Health New Orleans, pending a vote by the LSU Board of Supervisors. He has served as Interim Chancellor since fall 2021.

As part of his role, Dr. Nelson will oversee completion of the center's 10-year reaccreditation review cycle, a rigorous 18-month process designed to reflect the excellence of the program.

"We are grateful to Dr. Nelson for shepherding the LSU Health Sciences Center through this arduous but critically important process," said William F. Tate IV, LSU President. "His institutional knowledge and dedication to the center will no doubt lead to a positive outcome."

Dr. Nelson's career spans decades of progressively more senior academic medical leadership positions while consistently maintaining significant National Institutes of Health (NIH) funding, caring for critically ill patients, training hundreds of future healthcare professionals, and advancing healthcare policy to ensure optimal care for citizens across Louisiana.

After graduating with honors from the State University of New York at Stony Brook, Dr. Nelson earned his medical degree as a University Scholar at McGill University. At the Johns Hopkins Hospital, he completed his residency in Internal Medicine along with a Clinical Fellowship in Pulmonary/Critical Care Medicine and a Research Fellowship in Pulmonary Medicine.

Dr. Nelson joined the LSU School of Medicine faculty in 1984 and rapidly rose through the ranks, becoming Professor of Medicine in 1994 and the John H. Seabury Professor of Medicine in 1995. He served as Vice Chair of Research in the Department of Medicine and in 2005 was named Chief of the Section of Pulmonary/Critical Care Medicine. Dr. Nelson was appointed Dean of the Medical School in 2007 and President of the LSU Healthcare Network in 2009.

Dr. Nelson has been a National Science Foundation/National Institutes of Health funded investigator his entire academic career with more than \$45 million in extramural funding. He has authored or co-authored over 250 peer-reviewed journal papers, seven books/monographs and 30 book chapters.

Dr. Nelson's honors include membership in Alpha Omega Alpha (the medical honor society) and Delta Omega (the public health honor society) along with inclusion in multiple volumes of Best Doctors in America, Guide to America's Top Physicians, and New Orleans Magazine's Top Doctors. He was recognized in 2006 by the American College of Chest Physicians with its annual Edward C. Rosenow III Honor Lecture Award for outstanding contributions to mentorship and training of chest physicians. In 2019, Dr. Nelson received the prestigious Spirit of Charity Award in recognition of his significant medical contributions and compassionate care cultivated through years of practice at Charity Hospital. He is a Diplomate of the National Board of Medical Examiners, the American Board of Internal Medicine, and the American Board of Internal Medicine in Pulmonary Disease.

"Throughout my years at LSU, I have focused on educating the future healthcare professionals who will practice and serve in Louisiana, promoting the health of our citizens, and facilitating the translation of scientific discovery to the bedside. I am grateful that President Tate has entrusted me with the opportunity to continue to build on the successes of this exceptional institution."

Match Day

Match Day reveals 80% of LSU Health New Orleans medical graduates staying in Louisiana will enter LSU Health residency programs

175 students participated in the National Resident Match Program this year

On March 15, 2023, 175 LSU Health New Orleans graduating medical students gathered at Audubon Tea Room to discover the results of the annual National Resident Match Program (NRMP). Match Day results revealed that 80% of graduates staying in state will enter an LSU Health residency program.



Celebration Time!

Established in 1952, the NRMP is the primary system that matches applicants to residency programs with available positions at U.S. teaching hospitals and academic health centers. Students across the country found out on the same date and time where they matched and where they will spend their years of residency training, starting this July.

"This is a day that our senior students have anticipated for years, and the Match process has become increasingly competitive," says **Richard P. DiCarlo ('87)**, Interim Dean at the LSU Health New Orleans School of Medicine. "LSU Health New Orleans medical graduates are in demand and the high percentage that choose to remain with us for residency is a testament to the quality of our training programs and the dedication of our faculty."

The 54% of LSU Health New Orleans graduates who matched residency programs in other states will be attending some of the most prestigious out-of-state programs like Johns Hopkins, Duke, the Cleveland Clinic, Emory, Vanderbilt, Cornell, and the University of Alabama-Birmingham, among others.

"The vast majority of physicians providing care to the citizens of Louisiana are LSU Health-trained doctors," said LSU Health New Orleans Chancellor, Dr. Steve Nelson. "National studies have shown that many physicians set up their permanent practices in the communities where they complete their residency, but Louisiana is different.
