Dr. James H. Diaz is a professor of environmental/occupational health sciences at the LSU Health New Orleans School of Public Health. He is also a professor of anesthesiology and critical care medicine in the department of anesthesiology at the LSU Health New Orleans.

After receiving his medical degree from Tulane University School of Medicine, Dr. Diaz went on to obtain a master's degree in health administration, public health and tropical medicine, and a doctorate in public health all from Tulane University School of Public Health and Tropical Medicine. He completed residency training in general surgery, obstetrics and gynecology and anesthesiology at the University of Colorado Health Sciences Center, as well as a fellowship in pediatric anesthesia, critical care medicine and chronic pain management at the Children's Hospital of the University of Colorado. He is board-certified in preventive medicine, occupational medicine, medical toxicology, anesthesiology, critical care medicine, and pain management.

Dr. Diaz is a fellow of the American College of Occupational and Environmental Medicine, the American College of Preventive Medicine, the American College of Chest Physicians, and The American Academy of Pediatrics.
