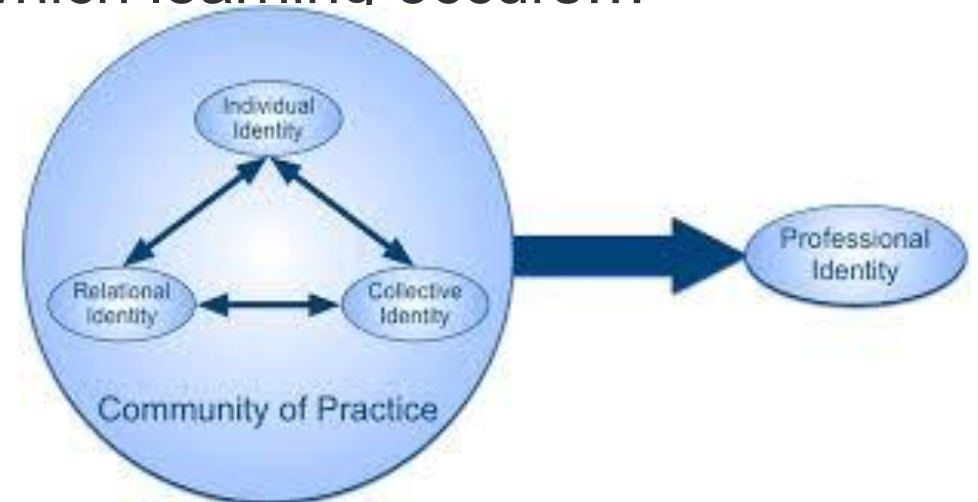
Foundation
