• PEDI 420 – Elective – Adolescent Medicine

o Students are assigned to adolescent medicine focused outpatient clinics including: outpatient adolescent medicine specialty and primary care clinics, School Based Health clinics, and as available. Expect to care for a variety of patients/medical issues including: Gyn and reproductive health, eating disorders, gender health services, primary/preventive care and behavioral health. Students will experience working with patients in-person and virtually. Individual projects and assignments from appropriate adolescent health resources are integral parts of this elective. Faculty members will evaluate the participation in each clinic and the rotation based on the student's attendance, interest, knowledge, clinical skills, and evidence of reading and utilizing resources to expand their interviewing and other skills in treating adolescents as well as the assigned projects.
