PEDI 420 - Elective - Child Abuse Pediatrics

o Students will become familiar with evidence-based recommendations in the medical evaluation of suspected child physical and sexual abuse. Students will learn about the roles and responsibilities of medical personnel in the identification and reporting of concerns of possible child abuse. Students will be able to observe clinical cases as well as multidisciplinary team meetings as available. Students are asked to work on a project/presentation on a topic of interest during the rotation (to present to staff for discussion). Faculty assessment is based on the observation of student's interest and performance during the elective. Space is limited.
