PEDI 420 – Elective Ambulatory Pediatrics Tiger Care Clinic/Children's ER

o Students will rotate in LSU's main primary care Pediatric clinic, Tiger Care, for 2 weeks and in Children's Hospital ER for 2 weeks. At Tiger Care, they will be exposed to a variety of patient visits including health maintenance exams for babies, children and adolescents as well as common pediatric problems that present to the ambulatory setting. Students are expected to see patients independently, develop history taking and physical exam skills, present patient assessments and management plans to faculty, and document their findings in the EHR. Rotating students are expected to attend resident conferences during this rotation. In the ER, students will see patients independently. Rotation objectives include taking medical histories, performing physical exams, and presenting assessments and management plans to faculty. Student are expected to attend weekly ER didactics in lieu of pediatric conferences during the rotation.
