• PEDI 420 – Elective Ambulatory Pediatrics – Tiger Care Clinic

o Students will rotate in LSU's main primary care Pediatric clinic, Tiger Care, for 4 weeks. During this time they will be exposed to a variety of patient visits including health maintenance exams for babies, children and adolescents. Students will learn health supervision guidelines for age-appropriate visits, focusing on health promotion and anticipatory guidance principles for patient/parent education. They will also see a variety of common pediatric problems that present to the Ambulatory setting. Students are expected to see patients independently, develop history taking and physical exam skills, then present patient assessments and management plans to faculty. They will also gain experience documenting outpatient visits in Epic EHR. Rotating students are expected to attend morning and noon resident conferences for pediatric didactic learning as well.
