PEDI 420 – Elective – Well-Baby Nursery/Tiger Care Clinic

o Students will rotate in LSU's main primary care Pediatric clinic, Tiger Care, for 2 weeks and in the Well Baby Nursey at Touro Infirmary for 2 weeks. At Tiger Care, students will be exposed to a variety of patient visits including health maintenance exams for babies, children and adolescents as well as common pediatric problems that present to the ambulatory setting. Students are expected to see patients independently, develop history taking and physical exam skills, present patient assessments and management plans to faculty, and document their findings in the EHR. Rotating students are expected to attend resident conferences during this rotation. While on service in the Well Baby Nursery, the student will function as an intern in the evaluation and treatment of newborns under the supervision of the Nursery attendings. The student is expected to play an active part in family-centered rounds, including patient examination and counseling of families in newborn care. Faculty evaluation of the student's performance will be based on attendance, interest, participation, and knowledge base of pertinent newborn guidelines.
