## **Chancellor Urges Return to Masking**

Dear LSU Health New Orleans Community,

Louisiana, like the rest of the country, is experiencing a high level of community transmission of COVID-19. Case numbers and hospitalizations have been steadily rising. Because mitigation measures have proven to be protective through prior surges, we would like to provide a brief reminder of our campuswide efforts:

### A) Masks:

- LSUHSC-NO requires that masks be worn properly (covering the nose and mouth) in all CLINICAL settings on campus (unless one is eating or drinking a beverage). A clinical setting is defined as any place on campus where patient activity is occurring.
- In student group laboratory settings, masks are required.
- Mask characteristics: When masking is required, personnel should wear AT LEAST a well-fitting surgical-grade mask (covering the nose and mouth). Cloth masks and neck "gaiters" are no longer acceptable. KN95 or N95 masks will be preferred in certain clinical and academic settings as per campus guidelines.
- In other small group settings, masks are highly advised, and mandatory masking may be instituted by course directors.

- In non-clinical administrative areas, masks are OPTIONAL.In the current conditions, mask usage is highly encouraged to avoid further mandates.
- When having meetings or gatherings, please be sensitive to others around you - ask if anyone would prefer masking and if so, please accommodate.
- Masks should be readily available in all bookstores.
- B) Social Distancing should be practiced at all times wherever possible.
- C) If you have been exposed and/or are having symptoms, please do not come to work and contact the campus clinic for further instruction.
- D) If you test positive, please stay home and contact the campus clinic or your primary care provider to be evaluated for treatment.

Of course, vaccinations reduce the risk of severe disease requiring hospitalization. Our Vaccination Clinic provides the Pfizer vaccine each week. You can make an appointment by calling 504-412-1995.

Thank you for doing your part to help keep our campuses safer.
