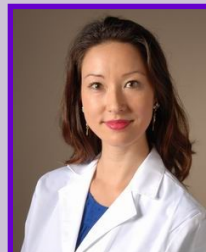
### Savannah Holloway

### Chandler Van Dyke



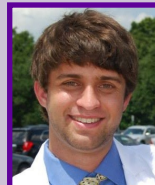
