### PROGRAM DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Last Spring, the Diagnostic Radiology Residency was granted a complement increase to 5 residents per year for a total of 20 residents. With the addition of the Interventional Radiology Integrated Residency the full complement of Radiology residents in 2024 will reach 30 residents. In addition, the Radiology department was granted approval for a new Musculoskeletal fellowship and a Neuroradiology Fellowship. While the Department is doing very well, the increased number of residents makes funding social and nondepartmental activities all the more challenging. The Interventional Radiology Residency at LSUHSC-NO has proudly become the state of Louisiana's first ACGME approved training site for the Interventional Radiology residency. Dr. Ricky Miller, who is now in his PGY-5 year, has matriculated into the program and will complete his training in 2020. In addition, the IR residency has welcomed its PGY2 class as the first full IR class to enter the Match and begin training at LSU. The residency has entered its third year and will again offer two spots in the Match this spring. The IR program has continued to grow and trainees are critical to integration of IR into other units of the hospital as they rotate in the ICU and with other surgical subspecialties. Residents have helped begin several research projects including studies on bone biopsy, hematology and liver disease both within UMCNO and in partnership with other institutions.
