ACADEMIC MEDICAL CENTER UPDATE

In late June 2013, the management of the Interim Louisiana State University Hospital transitioned from the state of Louisiana to a division of the Children's Hospital organization. The transition has been very smooth. Procedure volumes, which had declined due to budget cuts, have been on the rise. The future looks bright, especially with the anticipated move to the new Academic Medical Center in less than two years. Construction of the new Academic Medical Center is proceeding on budget and on time. The budget is \$1.063 billion. State appropriations provide \$300 million with the balance coming from FEMA and third party funding. The project costs approximately \$1 million per day. Target opening is June of 2015. LSU Radiology has recently been going through the process of selecting the imaging equipment for the Radiology Department which is on the third floor and is larger than a football field. The entire LSU Radiology Department is excited to watch this massive complex arise from ground up. Visit www.skanska.workzonecam.com to see the progress since ground breaking. The complex includes the 424 hospital, a multi-story Ambulatory Care Building, a parking structure, and a power plant. The historic McDonough School will likely be permanently repurposed on the site. This is a development of historic proportions and will be an exciting new chapter in the history of LSU Radiology.
