Laparotomy sponges comprising one or more closed metal wire loops incorporated into the fabric of the sponge are disclosed. The wire is of a gauge that is detectable by a metal detector. At least 50% of the area of the sponge is circumscribed by the one or more closed metal wire loops.

Investigational new drug (IND) 132408- Ferumoxytol (Prohance)
For use as a contrast agent in dynamic contrast enhanced magnetic resonance imaging (DCE MRI). A dual contrast model of DCE-MR1 is utilized, which improves the ability to extract separate contributions of vascular and parenchymal uptake of contrast agents in the pancreas. The rapid extravasation of conventional low molecular weight Gd chelate contrast agents from the blood plasma into the interstitial space limits the ability to separately and accurately model the vascular contribution to measured tissue contrast uptake curves. Ferumoxytol, in contrast, remains in the vascular space. With this additional information, early tumors are more easily identified, as well as the extent of tumors and their response to treatment
