Major Area of Research Interest:

My major research interest is in innovation and novel treatments for medical conditions. I have partnered with other researchers here at LSU and we have applied for five (5) patents since 2019 that cover hernia repair, absorbable stents for the prevention of anastomotic leaks, and the use of short chain fatty acids in the treatment of pancreatic cancer. These studies have led to multiple internal and external funding. The most successful venture has been the short chain fatty acid project, which based on multiple positive animal studies, is not being transitions to a larger human trial.
