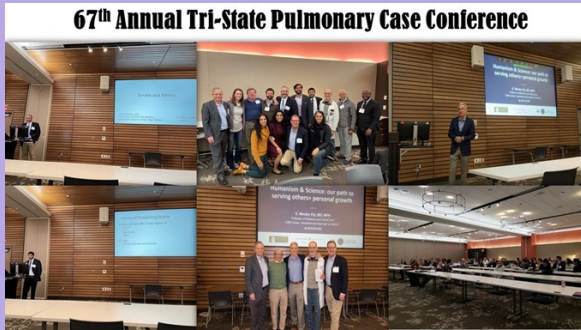


# DOM NEWS BLAST

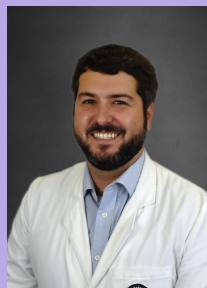
