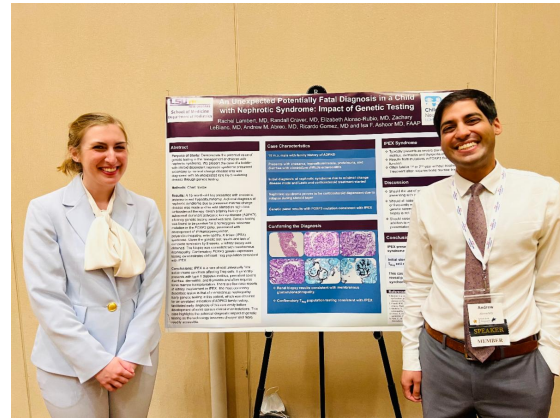

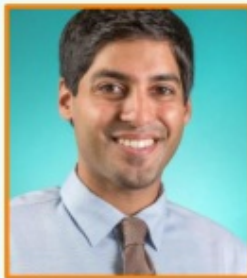

Andrew Abreo, MD, specializes in Pediatric Allergy and Immunology. He received his medical degree from LSU Health Shreveport and completed his residency training in Pediatrics at Children's National Hospital in Washington, D.C. He then completed a fellowship in Allergy and Immunology at Vanderbilt University Medical Center in Nashville, TN. He serves as an Assistant Professor of Pediatrics at LSU Health New Orleans. Dr. Abreo has a specific interest in eosinophilic esophagitis, and currently co-leads the multidisciplinary Eosinophilic Gastrointestinal Disorders Clinic with Dr. Colleen LeBlanc of Pediatric Gastroenterology. On why he chose to practice Pediatric Allergy and Immunology, Dr. Abreo said, "I want to improve the quality of life of children and families with allergic and immunologic disorders. I enjoy working with families to help their child feel as happy and healthy as possible."

Objectives: At the conclusion of this activity, participants should be able to:

1. Distinguish different types of adverse food reactions, including IgE-mediated food allergy.
2. Develop an evidence-based approach for the diagnosis of peanut allergy.
3. Identify potential future therapies for the management of peanut allergy.

Intended audience: This activity is specifically directed towards the pediatrician, but it is open to all other interested physicians, residents, medical students, and allied health professionals.
