Dr. Delacroix is the academic vice chair of the urology research department and director of cancer pathology at The LSU LCMC Health Cancer Center. His research interests include multidisciplinary teaching/instruction in urologic oncology and resident training. He also is exploring the role of MRI detection of prostate cancer as well as surgical reconstruction of the urinary system after trauma.

Dr. Delacroix is also committed to understanding the barriers to healthcare from a system standpoint as well as from a patient's perspective, for example, travel limitations, trust, education, and timeliness of treatments. He is identifying opportunities to implement core pathways in oncology care to assist in education improving trust between doctor and patient to improve compliance with advanced/multidisciplinary oncology treatments.

Dr. Delacroix graduated from LSU School of Medicine and LSU/Ochsner combined urology residency program. After graduation, Dr. Delacroix completed a fellowship at M.D. Anderson Cancer Center in Houston, TX before returning to LSU School of Medicine as faculty.
