Primary Care Program Committee

Description:

The Primary Care Program Committee oversees the primary care program under the guidance of the Family Medicine department. The committee is chaired by the Family Medicine Department Head and includes the director of AHEC, primary care faculty, representatives from the Office of Undergraduate Medical Education, current Rural Scholars Track (RST) or Primary Care Program (PCP) students, and (if possible) residents who were former RST or PCP students. This committee reports to the Curriculum Steering Committee. It aims to develop and enhance curricular experiences that focus on primary care. Faculty members facilitate identification and assignment of preceptors within the Urban Experience and Rural Experience pathways. The committee assesses the Primary Care Program as a whole on an annual basis, and reports findings to the Curriculum Steering Committee.
