

- **PEDI 420 – Elective – Early Childhood Development**

- o Each student will have an individualized schedule consisting of didactic sessions, developmental, genetics and neurology clinics, participation in an Operation House Call home visit to conduct a structured interview with a parent of a child with special health care needs, and if available, participation in an interdisciplinary autism evaluation with medical and allied health professionals. The student will also be required to choose a patient for a medical home case presentation to faculty and residents involved with the rotation that month. The student's interest, attendance, participation, and mastery of material presented as evidenced by participation in discussions and in-patient work ups will be evaluated. A competency exam, medical home presentation, and Operation House Call interview must be completed as part of the rotation.
